for calibrating, smart pitch operation, setting correct blade speed and testing main drive circuit reliefs, all done with a laptop setup of the WST.

The class ended around 2:00 p.m. with a question and answer session. MQ-Whiteman provided each attendee with a flash drive and all necessary handout for servicing and diagnosing the hydrostatic ride-on trowels. Multiquip-Whiteman provided door prizes of \$25 Starbuck gift cards for each attendee.
